

# **Elementary Education: Strategist Endorsement**

Degree Awarded: Bachelor of Arts

Certification Awarded: Instructional Strategist I & II (K-12) "ALL Strat" Endorsement

Students who are interested in Elementary Education (K-8) must earn a minimum 3.0 GPA in a prescribed liberal arts pre-education program and have a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA. (See Pre-Education Program and Application for Admission to Teacher Education in sections of the catalog).

This completion plan is designed for students entering as freshmen. First Year Seminar, Composition, and Quantitative Reasoning requirements are included on this plan, but students must fill in the remaining Core Curriculum requirements, any additional major and/or minor requirements, and electives and upper division courses.

Elementary Education students must earn a minimum 3.0 GPA in 65 semester credits required for the major and a minimum 3.0 GPA in coursework required for each additional endorsement. A grade of B or above must be earned in designated courses, and students must earn a grade of C or above in all other courses required for the major, each endorsement, and prerequisite courses. Students must earn a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA in all college work. Any request for a change in the sequence of curriculum for the Teacher Education Program must be submitted to the Education Department chair for consideration by the Education Department faculty. Successful completion of these requirements, and all other University graduation requirements will lead to program completion, which is required for recommendation for licensure in most states including lowa.

Major prerequisites and core courses are not included in the major GPA and are indicated with a \*. Prerequisites are not included in the major GPA (unless required for the content major or endorsements sought) and are indicated with a \*. This completion plan includes Strategist Endorsement courses, marked with a +. There are 4 different Strategist endorsement pathways that equal 24-31 credits depending on the pathway.
