Degree Awarded: Bachelor of Science in Nursing **Requirements for the Major:** 80 credits plus 7-12 prerequisite credits

At Grand View University, the baccalaureate program leading to a Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree is a blend of liberal arts and professional nursing education, which together results in the essential learning necessary for those interested in becoming professional nurses. The program prepares professional nurses who will practice in a variety of institutional and community settings. The purpose of the program is to develop nursing professionals who value learning and embody a caring ethic.

Admission to the program:

Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 to be admitted to Nursing, and must maintain a 3.0 GPA. Applicants for admission to the Nursing major must meet benchmark scores on the Pre-Admissions Benchmark Examinations and must have completed a minimum of these three required courses with a minimum grade of C:

All nursing students must earn a minimum of 3.0 cumulative GPA, as well as earning a 3.0 GPA for courses within the major, in order to graduate with a BSN degree. Students must achieve a C or above in all nursing major courses. The requirements for the licensed LPN are consistent with those for the traditional prelicensure students.

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
