Grand View is once again participating in the Council of Independent Colleges Consortium for Online Humanities Instruction. During the Fall 2017 semester, all full time GV students are eligible to enroll in an online course offered through one of the participating CIC institutions, subject to course prerequisites and space availability. No additional tuition or fees will be charged, but students will be responsible for their own books and supplies for the course.
