

 PAY PUBLIC** 

Many families believe a public university is the only affordable choice. Our new public price program means new first-year students can attend Grand View and enjoy all the perks of going to a small, private school for a price that is comparable to Iowa's large public universities! For qualifying Iowa seniors, out-of-pocket cost for tuition will not exceed \$11,000 (the average cost of the three Iowa public universities).
