	<b>Login to myGVU</b> If you have not already done so, log into GV's app/portal – https://myGVU.grandview.edu – or download from your phone's app store. You should have received an email from Admissions providing your GV Account username and initial password. If you do not have this information, email helpdesk@grandview.edu. <b>Log in regularly – all official communication will be directed to this account.</b>	
	myGVU Tasks Continue to monitor <i>Tasks</i> (upper left corner) of myGVU.  Tasks are important steps you need to take to help you be successful at Grand View.

	<b>FAFSA</b> Complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online at <i>www.studentaid.gov</i> . Grand View's school code is 001867.	
	<b>Financial Aid Offer Letter</b> View and accept your financial aid by logging into <i>myGVU</i> > <i>Student Finances</i> > <i>Open Financial Aid Information in Self Service</i> . You will see the checklist items you need to take action on in yellow, including reviewing and accepting your Financial Aid Offer Package and reviewing and signing your Financial Aid Offer Letter.	
	Payment Plan To set up a payment plan to cover your remaining out-of-pocket costs, go to: myGVU > My Finances > Enroll in a Payment Plan. In order to have a 6-month payment plan, you must enroll by December 15, 2025. The first payment will be due by January 15, 2025. Viking Central can assist you in setting up a plan. Contact the office at 515-263-2807 or VikingCentral@grandview.edu.	
	<b>Financial Responsibility</b> Accept financial responsibility for tuition. Go to: <i>myGVU &gt; My Tasks &gt; Financial Responsibility Statement</i> .	
	<b>Financial Aid Authorization</b> Authorize Grand View to credit financial aid to any miscellaneous charges. Go to: <i>myGVU &gt; My Tasks &gt; Apply Financial Aid to Misc Charges Authorization</i> .	
	<b>Federal Direct Loan Online Promissory Note &amp; Entrance Counseling</b> If you will be taking out a Federal Student Loan, complete online at www.studentaid.gov.	
	<b>Federal PLUS Loan</b> If you will be applying for a Federal PLUS loan, your parent needs to apply online and complete a Master Promissory Note at www.studentaid.gov. Your parent will need an FSA ID. For more information, go to: myGVU> My Finances > Student Finances > Loan Information.	
	Private Loan If you will be applying for a private loan, find more information and the private loan list link, go to: myGVU > My Finances > Go to Student Finances > Private Loans. Notify your completion coach which loan you decide to take so we may update your Active Financial Plan.	
	<b>Employer Partner Advantage</b> If you are employed by a Grand View Employer Partner, please fill out the discount form before classes start to	

confirm employment and receive the tuition discount. GV partners and the discount can be found at: www.grandview.edu/about/employee-partnerships

	<b>Student ID</b> Go to: <i>myGVU &gt; About Me &gt; Upload Photo for Campus ID</i> and follow the prompts to upload your photo. You will receive your Grand View student ID at Orientation. Or visit Campus Services during Orientation.	
	<b>Vehicle Registration</b> If you plan to have a vehicle on campus, complete your registration at: $myGVU > Tasks > Vehicle Check-In for Permit$ .  Then pick up your parking decal in Campus Services located inside the Bookstore. Current school year decals are available beginning in August and can be picked up any time throughout the school year. If you will not have a vehicle, you can request a parking fee waiver via the Vehicle Check-In task.	
	<b>Vector Training</b> You will receive a link to the required training in your Grand View email.	
В	EFORE CLASSES BEGIN	
	<b>Person Proxy</b> allows you to give a parent or anyone of your choosing access to your student account, academic record and financial aid information. Grand View does not mail paper statements, so this is the way others access your account information. You can set up your Proxy access via <i>myGVU</i> > <i>Tools</i> > <i>About Me</i> > <i>Manage Person Proxy</i> for your account.	
	<b>Student Record Release</b> Authorizes the university to share your financial aid and billing information with a parent, guardian, or another designated individual. Students participating in the <b>GV Complete program</b> are required to authorize at least one parent or guardian unless they are considered <b>independent for financial aid purposes</b> . To complete, go to <i>myGVU</i> > <i>Tools</i> > <i>About Me</i> > <i>Release My Student Records</i>	
	<b>Schedule</b> Access on <i>myGVU &gt; My Academics</i> before classes start and verify your courses are correct using Student Planning.	
	<b>Purchase Books</b> Visit the Bookstore or order online at <i>www.bookstore.grandview.edu</i> . We recommend students begin purchasing books at least two weeks prior to the start of school.	
	<b>Resources on myGVU</b> Familiarize yourself with resources available: course schedule, term calendar, campus life, academics, career services, clubs and organizations.	
	Academic Advisor Once your advisor has been assigned, you can review that information in your account information on myGVU.	
	<b>Handshake</b> Download the Handshake app or log in at joinhandshake.com using your Grand View email address and password. In Handshake, you have access to on-campus/work-study job opportunities, employer events and contact information, and thousands of job and internship postings.
