We have an exciting program that will cover the full cost of tuition for eligible students. There is also no requirement to live on campus if you qualify for a housing exemption. Please check our residency requirement at grandview.edu/res-reg.

## To be eligible for GV Next, students must:

- Be an lowa resident enrolling as a full-time day student, earning their first bachelor's degree beginning in spring 2024 and after.
- Be eligible for the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and file by the June 30 deadline for the filing year.
- Stay in good academic standing while enrolled as a full-time day student.
- Qualify for the maximum Federal Pell Grant\* or have a parent Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) of \$60,000 or less for the filing year.

\*NOTE: AGI parameters are not applicable to transfer students

GV Next uses federal and state funds along with Grand View scholarships and grants to cover the cost of tuition. If a student chooses to live on campus, they will be responsible for the cost of housing and a meal plan. In addition, students will also be responsible for fees and books/supplies needed for courses. Students will continue to receive the full tuition benefit as long as they meet the requirements based on the results of their FAFSA for each year they are at Grand View.

## What if a student doesn't qualify?

Grand View offers generous scholarship and aid packages that make a college education affordable for all students. Last year 99% of our full-time students received financial assistance. The average financial aid package for new first-year students exceeds \$31,523 with more than \$26,386 in scholarships and grants.
