



## Post-Master's Certificate – Clinical Mental Health Counseling

**Degree Awarded:** Certificate

**Requirements for the Degree:** 24 credits

The Post-Master's Certificate in Clinical Mental Health Counseling is intended for individuals with a master's degree in counseling (any concentration) from a CACREP-accredited program. The certificate will allow students to meet Iowa's Licensed Mental Health Counselor (LMHC) specialization requirements.
