

Post-Master's Certificate – School Counseling

Degree Awarded: Certificate Requirements for the Degree: 27 credits

The Post-Master's Certificate in School Counseling is intended for individuals with a master's degree in counseling (any concentration) from a CACREP-accredited program. The certificate will allow students to meet Iowa's Professional School Counselor endorsement specialization requirements.

*Students will choose a K-8 or 5-12 professional school counselor endorsement. For candidates seeking both the K-8 and 5-12 endorsements, a minimum of 100 hours of the practicum or internship experiences listed above must be completed at each desired endorsement level.

All courses above will be counted in computing the 3.0 GPA required for this program. No more than two grades of C+, C, or C- can apply to the degree. SC students must earn a B- or better in CMGR 594, 596, 597.
