INTERNATIONAL SOCIAL PROBLEMS

Learn how Danes and Germans address social problems and respond to marginalized populations, and use that knowledge to develop ideas on how to influence stateside social programs and practices. Students will examine their own bias and privilege, and through understanding the culture of Denmark and Germany, will be better able to advocate for self or others to create a more just society.

COURSES

International Social Problems will be explored through two courses: LIBA 350-Core Seminar II and SOCS 315-Social Problems. The study tour program is part of the summer term and includes one course (3 credit hours). Academic credit requires engagement in pre-study tour class sessions the weeks prior to departure where students to learn how targeted social issues are addressed in the U.S. and Iowa.

APPROXIMATE COST \$3,900

Includes airfare, lodging, ground transport, meals, entrance to all educational and most leisure excursions, and administrative fee
