

FBG's cleaning efforts are focused on infection prevention and control. The disinfectants we use are recommended by the CDC and EPA registered to kill COVID-19, we use: Virex 256 and Oxivir Five 16. We would utilize these disinfectants on the touchpoints around campus.

Our Electrostatic Disinfection System (EDS) produces small, electrically charged microdroplets that repel (not overlap) each other, enabling our hospital – grade disinfectant to reach 100% of all exposed and hidden surfaces. Electrostatics is the process of adding an electric charge to liquid droplets when sprayed. Within minutes, the fine mist dries and the protective solution bonds. We would also have an EDS unit on campus at all times.

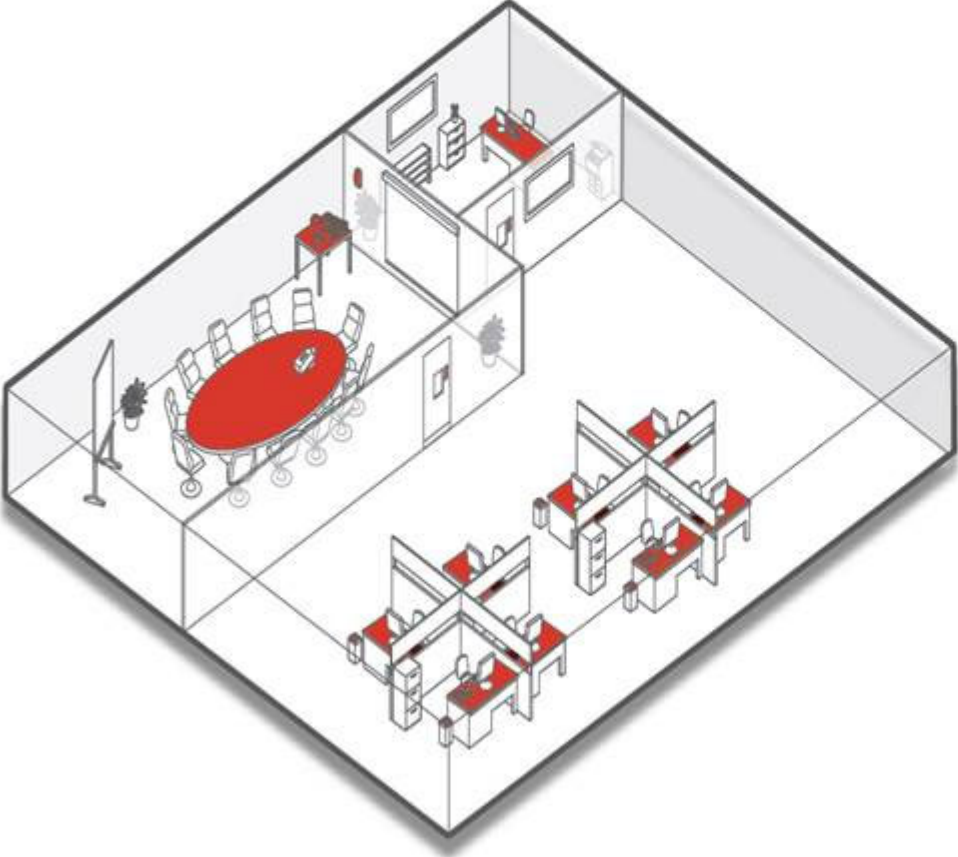
Wellness Center

High risk infection areas need to be cleaned on a regular basis to create protection against pathogen spread. Certain conditions allow pathogens to spread easier from one individual to another. These include areas where traffic is high, bodily spills are frequent or where there is general low level of hygiene.

Miscellaneous

Elevator buttons/handles
Stairwell handles
Entryways
Maintaining, cleaning and restocking of any disinfecting hand sanitizer/soap in public places
Multiple restroom checks throughout the day for touchpoint disinfecting and restocking of all consumable items
In the Wellness Center/fitness areas: at least one day a week an EDS spraying would occur

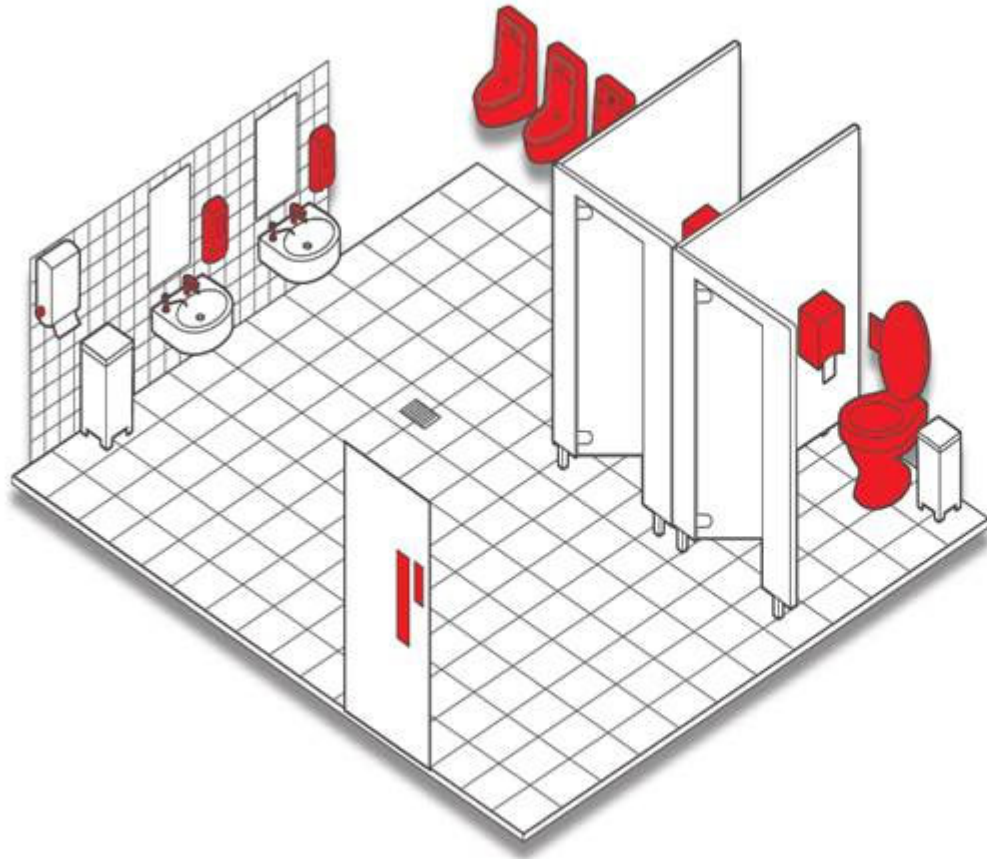

3. Deal with blood or other bodily fluid spillages immediately
