ABOUT GRAND VIEW UNIVERSITY

Grand View University is a liberal arts institution located in Des Moines, Iowa. As the state capital with a population exceeding half a million, Des Moines offers GV students diverse cultural and entertainment attractions, as well as outstanding opportunities for internships, jobs, and other educational experiences.

The university was founded in 1896 by Danish immigrants and is affiliated with the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America. More than 2,000 students choose from 40 majors, including music and music education programs. For nearly two decades, close to 100 percent of GV graduates have secured employment or entered graduate school within six months of graduation. Typically, more than 98% of our full-time day undergraduate students receive financial assistance, totaling more than \$36.5 million. Grand View offers 25 sports for men and women, as well as athletic scholarships. With more than 40 clubs and campus organizations and honors programs, students have many opportunities to get involved and learn to lead for life. Grand View's College for Professional and Adult Learning serves



students in central Iowa offering several majors, online and in-person allowing students to work full-time while they complete a degree.

Grand View offers five graduate programs: Master of Science in Athletic Training, Master of Education, Master of Science in Nursing, Master of Science in Organizational Leadership, and Master of Science in Sport Management.

Recent Grand View Highlights

The Music Department moved into its renovated facility in 2016. The location provides increased space for rehearsals, classroom teaching, studio teaching, and practice rooms. In other campus improvements, the Student Center opened for students Fall 2016 and houses performance spaces, campus dining facilities, classrooms, and office space for various departments. GV continues to engage in international partnerships, including opportunities for exchange in Denmark and China.

He received his Bachelor of Music Degree from Simpson College in 1992. Steve also earned an Associate Arts degree in Commercial Art from DMACC in 2001.

His professional affiliations include, or have included, the Iowa Bandmasters Association, South Central Iowa Bandmasters Association, and Jazz Educators of Iowa. He has served as Jazz Affairs Chairperson for the South Central Iowa Bandmasters Association and member of the Iowa High School Music Association Concert Band Literature Review Committee. Ensembles under his direction have consistently received superior ratings in Concert Band, Marching Band, and Jazz Band. In 2003, the Carlisle Jazz Band placed first at the Iowa Jazz Championships and in 2004, the Carlisle Concert Band received the Sweepstakes Award at the Worlds of Fun Concert Band Festival.
