Her passion for inspiring young students to engage their creativity through the arts is exemplified through her first two published books: *Little Miss Mary Discovers Music Outside Her Window* and *Little Miss Mary Discovers the Piano*. When Crandell is not teaching or writing, she enjoys spending time with her husband, Myron Peterson, practicing yoga as well as reading music journals and IBA Archives.
