

Endorsement Instructional Strategist II: Learning Disabilities and Behavioral Disorders K-12

This is a K-12 Endorsement that can be completed <u>in addition to</u> a first endorsement. Students majoring in Elementary Education are required to select at least one endorsement area in addition to the Elementary Education major requirements. Students majoring in Secondary Education or K-12 Art, Music, or Physical Education may complete this endorsement <u>in addition to</u> their first content endorsement area.

Students must earn a minimum 3.0 GPA in courses required for the major and each endorsement. The grade of B or above must be earned in designated education major pre-admission and major courses, and students must earn a grade of C or above in all other courses required for the major pre-admission courses, major, and each endorsement.
