

Secondary Endorsement American Government 5-12

Students majoring in Secondary Education must complete the prescribed pre-education requirements, the requirements for the Secondary Education major, and at least one content endorsement. This endorsement can be <u>combined with another social sciences endorsement</u> to be submitted as the student's first content endorsement.

Students must earn a minimum 3.0 GPA in courses required for the major and each endorsement. The grade of B or above must be earned in designated education major pre-admission and major courses, and students must earn a grade of C or above in all other courses required for the major pre-admission courses, major, and each endorsement. Please see the university catalog for additional information.

Note: The faculty of the education department strongly advise the additional completion of the All Social Sciences endorsement.

Iowa Teaching Endorsement: #157

Requirements for the Endorsement: Methods coursework plus either 15 credits content area coursework if pursuing licensure as a Social Sciences teacher or 30 credits if not pursuing licensure as a Social Sciences teacher. It is recommended you complete 30 credits by completing 15 credits in two social sciences.
