

Complementary Secondary Endorsement World History 5-12

Complementary teaching endorsements support initial Secondary Education teaching licenses. These complementary endorsements authorize a teacher to teach in additional content areas in grades 5-12. Students must earn a minimum 3.0 GPA in courses required for each endorsement. No D grades are accepted. Please see the Secondary Education major sheet and/or the university catalog for additional information.

After completing any 5-12 Secondary Education Initial Content Endorsement, a World History Endorsement may be added. Those not licensed as Social Sciences teachers must earn a minimum of 24 credit hours in World History to earn this complementary endorsement.

Note: The complementary endorsements of American History (#158) and World History (#166) are embedded within a double major in Secondary Education and History. The faculty of both the Education and History departments strongly advise the additional completion of the All Social Sciences endorsement (#186).
