**Degree Awarded:** Bachelor of Arts

**Requirements for the Major:** 65-66 credits plus 11 prerequisite credits

The major in Accounting develops the technical proficiency and the conceptual, analytical, and communication skills required in the Accounting profession. The Accounting program strives to prepare students for careers in all areas of Accounting-in both public and private concerns. Outstanding Accounting Students are recognized every year by the Iowa Society of CPAs, and the Institute of Management Accountants. Completion of the Accounting program and the requisite credit hours will allow you to sit for the Certified Public Accountant examination in Iowa, and students are encouraged to do so.

The Accounting degree can be completed in its entirety in either the day or evening/online programs. The Accounting Department also offers one post-baccalaureate certificate program.
