The major in Church Music integrates the study of Music and Theology with the intention of preparing students to serve as church musicians. Coursework is drawn from both the Theology and Music Departments in order to provide foundations in both fields and thereby create a framework for effective decision-making, communication with clergy partners, and performance skills. Students majoring in Music must achieve a grade of C or better in all the required courses in the major in order to graduate.
