



## Music Education (K-12)

### Iowa Teaching Endorsements #144 (K-8) and #145 (5-12)

**Degree Awarded:** Bachelor of Arts

**Requirements for the Major:** 92 credits

Students who are interested in Music Education (K-12) must earn a minimum 3.0 GPA in a prescribed liberal arts pre-education program, have a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA, and successfully pass all three Core Academic Skills for Educators tests before they are formally admitted to the teacher education program of the University. (See Pre-Education Program and Application for Admission to Teacher Education in sections of the catalog).

Music Education students must earn a minimum 3.0 GPA in coursework required for the major and a minimum 3.0 GPA in coursework required for each complementary endorsement pursued. A grade of B or above must be earned in designated courses, and students must earn a grade of C or above in all other courses required for the major, each endorsement, and prerequisite courses. Students must earn a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA in all college work. Any request for a change in the sequence of curriculum for the Music Education Program must be submitted to the Education and Music Department chairs for consideration by the faculty of both departments. Successful completion of these requirements, all other University graduation requirements, and all State of Iowa teacher licensure requirements will lead to a recommendation to the State of Iowa Board of Educational Examiners for an Iowa teaching license.

**Pre-education Requirements/Pre-requisites for courses in the major:** Minimum 3.0 GPA required (11 credits toward the major plus 12-13 credits toward General Education Core Requirements)
