Note: Student are expected to have continuous enrollment and maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0. While all course grades are averaged in GPA, course credit toward degree completion is not granted for grade of an C or below. A maximum of one course (3 hours) with a grade of a "B-" can count toward graduation, but the student must maintain a GPA of 3.0. Students who receive a grade less than B- may repeat the course and replace the initial grade. *Students should be aware that some state licensure boards do not accept any course work with a grade below B-. Students with a

cumulative GPA below a 3.0 will be placed on academic probation and may be dismissed from the program by the Graduate College. Students who have not attended Grand View, least part-time status for two or more consecutive semesters (not including summer), must re-apply for admissions. To graduate with a degree of Master of Science in Clinical Mental Health Counseling students must successfully complete 60-semester credits in the program and maintain a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or higher throughout the program.
