This form must be completed by the student, in cooperation with a Grand View University faculty member who has consented to serve as the student's academic advisor, and submitted to the appropriate College Dean for presentation to the Curriculum and Educational Policy Committee before the end of the first semester of the student's junior year. All requests approved by the Committee will be signed by the Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs and placed in the student's file in the Registrar's Office.
