WHAT DOES IT MEAN?

Statement of Account

The official statement showing what is due for tuition, fees, room & board. This statement includes actual charges and pending financial aid and is available online through GV Self Service. Keep in mind the aid is not final until all eligibility requirements have been met.

Payment Plan

Set up with our third party processor), based on actual amounts listed on the Statement of Account. Contact Viking Central for assistance.

GV Complete Financial Plan

Provides an estimate of overall cost of the four-year degree based on enrollment and housing projections, as well as estimated financial aid. Once a student has received a financial aid offer letter, this plan helps families understand payment options for covering remaining out-of-pocket expenses.

Financial Aid Offer Letter

This shows the actual financial aid the student is eligible for and includes an estimate of tuition, fees, room & board. Students can also view it on *myGVU > Tools > My Finances > SelfService > Financial Aid > Offer Letter*. If a student changes their enrollment, housing, or FAFSA, changes will be made to their financial aid offer and the student will be notified by email when those changes are ready to view in Self-Service.
