

Chapter 35: Dependents Education Assistance Program (DEA)

How to apply for and use Chapter 35 benefits at Grand View University (GV)

- 1. Apply and be accepted to GV
- 2. Provide to GV School Certifying Official (SCO)
 - Your Certificate of Eligibility
 - Visit http://www.benefits.va.gov/gibill/get_started.asp to apply for benefits, if not already completed
 - The full VA File number (generally includes the social security number of the service member/sponsor)
 - If you've used your benefits at another college or university, complete a Request for Change of Program or Place of Training (VA Form 22-5495)
- 3. Work with an academic advisor to register for courses inform the SCO when registered

How Chapter 35 GI Bill® benefits work

GV SCO will submit your enrollment about a month prior to the start of the semester in Fall and Spring terms (Fall and Spring are automatically certified after receipt of Certificate of Eligibility; Summer terms require annual student certification request). Schedule changes may impact your entitlement amount, creating a VA debt you will be responsible to repay.

You will receive funds based on your enrollment status for each term. VA standards for enrollment status may vary from GV standards. The VA prorates payments for partial months of school.

You are responsible for paying Grand View. Please contact Student Accounts if you need to set up a payment plan.

Rates effective 10-1-2023

Full time = \$1,488.00 per month

¾ time = \$ 1176.00 per month

 $\frac{1}{2}$ time = \$ 862.00 per month

¼ time = \$ 372 per month (or the cost of tuition and fees, whichever is less)

The entitlement is for 36 months or 45 months if first used entitlement prior to 8/1/18 of full-time enrollment, and the delimiting (eligibility end) date varies based on relationship to the service member.
