Typically, more than 99% of our full-time day undergraduate students receive financial assistance.

The average financial aid package for new freshmen exceeds \$36,395, with more than \$24,010 in scholarships and grants and the remainder in work-study and loans.

The **GV COMPLETE** program is designed to help make a Grand View education more affordable, more predictable and to support students in making the very most out of the scholarships, grants, and loans that will become key parts of financing. Students meet with completion coaches to plan and finance an entire degree right from the beginning, creating a four-year financing plan and a four-year academic plan. All first-year students and full-time day transfer students who transfer in 66 credits or fewer are eligible to participate.

SCHOLARSHIPS GV academic and need-based scholarships are renewable four-year scholarships available to new full-time day students.
