

## **Housing Exemption Form**

Students in their first three years of college (not determined by credits) are required to live in college housing. Exempted from this policy are students who have reached their twenty-second birthday prior to the first day of class; veterans of at least two years active military service; married students living with their spouse; students who have dependent children living with them; students who commute to school daily from the permanent, legal residence of their parent(s)/legal guardian (within 30 miles); students who have attended college for at least two years and held an off campus lease agreement during the two years of enrollment prior to attending Grand View; and students who have graduated from high school three or more years ago.

Note: Students currently living on campus may not apply for an exemption as a means of cancelling an active housing contract. This housing exemption form must be turned in before a student's fall move-in date in order to be considered for that academic year.

If you are under the age of 22 prior to the first day of the term, you must do the following in order to be considered for a housing exemption:

- Complete, sign and return the housing exemption application.
- A parent, grandparent or legal guardian must also sign the housing exemption application if you are under 22 and requesting an exemption to commute from the permanent home of your parent(s), grandparent(s) or legal guardian (within a 30 mile radius).
